Private ranch calls on location

- Ranch Call (single horse):** **\$125**
Covers conformation, liberty and optional under-saddle images, online proofs with optional passcode lock and proof book.
- Ranch Call (multiple horses):** **\$75**
Price is per horse. Covers conformation, liberty and optional under-saddle images, online proofs with optional passcode lock and proof book.
- Ranch Call Special:** **\$99**
Covers conformation and liberty images, online proofs with optional passcode lock and two WFDI.
- Marketing Special:** **\$250**
Covers conformation, liberty and optional under-saddle images, online proofs with optional passcode lock and full page ad layout.
- 4-H Student Discount:** **\$50**
Includes portrait session with student plus choice of conformation, liberty or under-saddle images and online proofs with optional passcode lock.

Booking

Payment is due in full upon photographer's arrival at the agreed upon location. Clients must fill out and sign the Statement of Agreement and Understanding prior to the photography session of their equine.

Travel

Mileage charged at \$0.60 per mile after the first 45 miles. Locations outside 150 miles are billed at-cost for airfare, lodging and meals, etcetera and a non-refundable down payment of 50% estimated travel costs is required at time of booking.

Being Prepared

Photographing your equine can be a fun and rewarding time but takes a collaborative effort to be done effectively. At least three people are needed with a few more if a liberty session is to be done. It is recommended that your horse is bathed and clipped well in advance to the scheduled photo time. All coat products to enhance the shine of the animal, as well as "greasing" up the face should be applied within minutes of photographing. Be sure to consider what you would like to present your horse in, taking care to have clean tack that is appropriate to your breed or presentation purpose. It is the little details that really help your horse to stand out in the image! If you are opting for a liberty session, please choose an area no smaller than 100x100' that your horse is familiar with. This area should have safe fencing and be open for the horse and photographer to move around in. It is highly recommended that all small animals be contained so as not to interfere with the horse(s).
